## Locate the scheme closest to your destination

We have Shopmobility schemes in **25** locations, in **14** towns and cities in Northern Ireland.

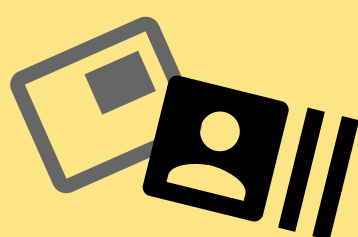
## Go to the scheme location

Most schemes are happy for you to simply come into the shop whenever you're close by. If you want to be absolutely certain you won't have to wait, you can call them and book a suitable time to come in.



## Fill out the Membership Form

All Shopmobility schemes are membership-based. This helps us to better know what equipment you need and to make sure you're comfortable as well as safe.



## Provide 2 forms of Identification

We ask for photographic ID as well as confirmation of your home address.



## We will train you on the equipment you want to use

Wheelchairs are simple to operate, but scooters can be dangerous if not used properly. We will train you so that you are confident and happy, as well as safe. Safety is hugely important to us.

## That's it!

On your first visit the whole process should take around 30-40 minutes, so give yourself time when you call in. From then on, we'll make sure your training is refreshed each year and if you have any questions at all, ask a staff member or volunteer. We are here to help!
